ISAIAH 40:28


For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you.

"And don't be concerned about what to eat and what to drink. Don't worry about such things.






And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.
