We don't need to live in anxiety, but instead, if we take all our concerns to Him and trust Him to take care of us, we can actually live in peace—despite the instability we find in the world.



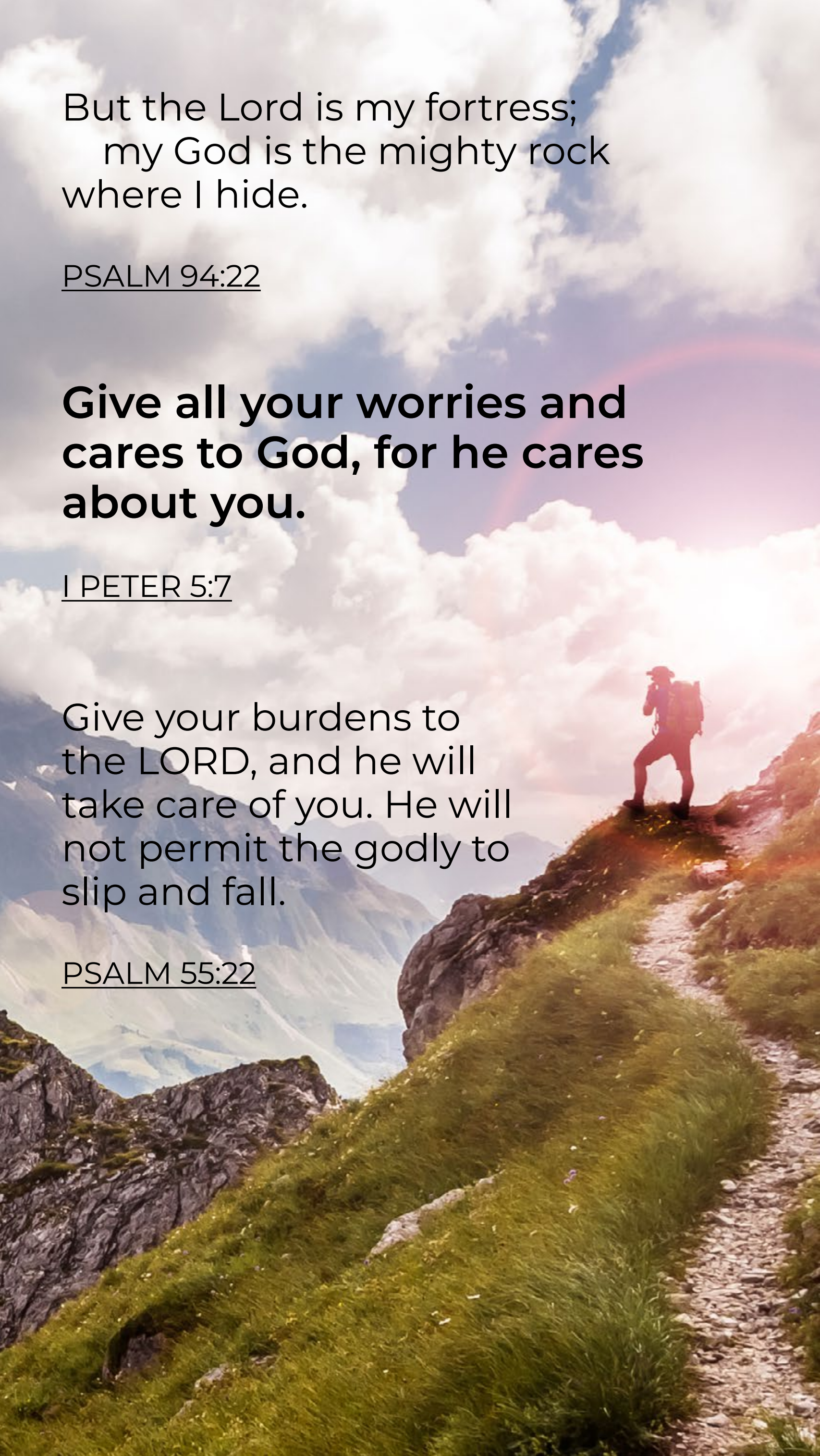


These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers all over the world, but your Father already knows your needs.


