


Have you ever seen a fish get taken out of water and placed on the ground?

Of course, the fish would probably not know what water is, but it would recognize it as "home," the place where they could live with freedom—free from discomfort and death.




Humans behave similarly.

We are floundering, grasping, reaching for a place where we will not feel so dislocated, aimless—wanting assurance that our lives have value.




Purpose


Significance

You may be tempted to think that only the people with big, important jobs live significant lives.


But that just isn't true.
