It was still dark, and everything in his body begged him to stay in bed. But his spirit sang a different story.

Jean Benoit was on his way to meet a group of pastors. They were getting together to discuss the upcoming Ignite Evangelism Events that would build up the churches in their region.

But the journey was a difficult one.

The roads were hazardous. Jean Benoit and his

team had to rent a truck to make the journey and with no bridges over the river, the truck had to wade through the water. In the two-and-a-half hours they had been driving, they had crossed through the river 52 times!

But their journey wasn't done.

To make it to the meeting, Jean Benoit had to travel another two-hours by motorcycle. When he finally arrived, he had been traveling for four-and-a-half hours.

He was nearly two hours late. And it was completely worth it!

Despite all the difficulty associated with ministry

work in Haiti, your crucial, ongoing financial support empowered Jean Benoit to meet up with this eager group of pastors. And the result was inspiring.

Together, the group hosted three Ignite events in August. They partnered with 56 churches and presented the Gospel with Scripture to 275 people!

Meet Kara. Kara is passionate about spreading the Gospel, so when she had the chance to join a Gospel Outreach (GO) Trip to Chile, she was ecstatic.

She couldn't wait to share the Good News about Jesus in a foreign country and build up the local church to do the same. She desperately hoped to change someone's life with the Gospel.

That's when she met Javiera.

"I saw a mother who was waiting outside of the vaccination clinic. After talking with her for a little while, I discovered she has a daughter who is the same age as my daughter," Kara said.

"We became mothers right at the beginning of this pandemic. So, we were able to talk about how lonely it was to be a new mom during a time when our families couldn't provide all the support they usually would."

"I shared that I had lost my job and my husband was out of work as well. I had every reason to panic, but I knew that God had always taken care of me in the past and he was going to take care of us now," she added.

As the two shared their lives with one another, a Gospel spark began to grow.

Kara shared about the hope that had pulled her through these tough times. The loneliness of being a

new mom during a lockdown, and the anxiety created by job loss. She shared the Gospel.

"Javiera looked very emotional. Then we prayed together and she gave her life to Jesus just as her husband and her daughter came out of the clinic. We left the family with information about the Generación de Fe Church who was partnering with us. We pray that they are able to find a big and welcoming family at church," Kara said.

Stories like this show just how meaningful your ongoing and faithful support is. Because of you, people like Javiera all around the world are able to hear the message of the Gospel and turn to Christ. Amen!

You know that feeling of frustration you get when you're stuck in traffic. You're sitting in your car, staring at the same bumper that's been in front of you for an hour as you wait to get home.

Now imagine if your journey home took a full 24-hours.

For the Ribeirinhos who live in the Amazon Basin this is their reality. It can often take a full day of nonstop travel to get from any major city to the villages they call home. The Journey is difficult. Travelers change buses three times along a route consisting of unpaved and unsteady roads. They negotiate narrow cliffside roads that seem impossibly narrow.

After that, you have to hop on a boat and travel down the river. It's a journey that keeps many missionaries away. Because of this, the true message of the gospel hasn't been heard by most of the people in these communities.

And even if they've heard, they have no church to go to, or even Scripture resources to lean on.

But your ongoing monthly support is changing that.

It is sending believers from the Brazilian church into these communities to reach out to people like 15-year-old Misael. Like many children in the river communities, his father left home in search of work when Ismael was just a toddler.

He never came back.

Growing up with a single mother and younger siblings, Ismael had to take on duties beyond his years. He felt adrift and abandoned in the absence of a father to provide guidance.

This weighed heavily on Ismael's lean shoulders.

He believed he was unworthy of anything nice in life as a result. He concluded that his father didn't

think it was worthwhile to raise him. "I must be worthless," he concluded.

Ismael's mother began to worry as she saw her son befriend gang members known to experiment with drugs. She feared losing him. She felt powerless to stop him.

That's when the gospel intervened.

The financial support of donors like you, sent our ministry partners in Brazil on the nearly 4,000 km Gospel Outreach (GO) Trip from Sao Paulo to Ismael's village to share the gospel.

The group met Ismael's mother first. She shared what her son was going through. While they were talking, Ismael entered the house. The group gave him a Faísca (Spark) magazine and shared God's plan of salvation with him.

Ismael was intrigued, but still a little wary. So he followed the team from house to house. He listened by the windows of each house as the GO Team shared the gospel with his entire village.

After an afternoon of hearing them speak, Ismael's heart had changed.

Now, Ismael's eyes glowed with wonder as he flipped through his magazine's glossy pages. For the first time, he realized his Father in heaven would never leave nor forsake him. This knowledge lifted the heavy burden he had carried for most of his short life. His eyes filled with tears. As he heard more of the Good News, Ismael decided to chart a new path and gave his life to Jesus with an open heart.

Ismael was headed for a life of misery and destruction. But thanks to your faithful support his life has a new story!

Emergency relief packages bring the hope of the gospel to Ukraine



iCare packages provide much needed physical relief to those affected by the war in Ukraine. And thanks to you, all those packages also provide spiritual relief in the form of Scriptures.

We've all been horrified to see the death and destruction in Ukraine. But your prayers and monthly financial support are making a difference. Your generosity is placing Scripture magazines in emergency *iCare* food packages that are being distributed in Ukraine and among Ukrainian refugees in surrounding countries.

It cannot be overstated what a profound source of spiritual comfort this continues to be.

It is even more desperately needed now, in the face of devastating news from our partners at Mission Eurasia in Ukraine. One of the mission's ministry centers, which was used as a main office, housing for staff, and a place where *Light* magazines were printed, was caught in violent crossfire. After the attack, the Russian army intentionally burned all the Scripture material left in the building.

Barry Garner, a representative of Mission Eurasia in Poland, recently met with a group of Ukrainian refugees who were heartbroken when they received the news about the center.

He told us about one of the women who used to live in the building because her husband worked as a driver and evangelist for the mission.

“Listening to her talk about how fast they had to evacuate, and things that they left behind that are now burned ... it's devastating,” says Barry. “All their earthly belongings were in that place. Now, here they are, living as refugees, missing the people and things they love.”

Thankfully, all the staff survived the shelling and have been able to get their families safely to western Ukraine, Poland, and Moldova. And the work is continuing.

ShareWord Global partners plan to distribute 300,000 Scripture magazines with the *iCare* relief boxes for families in need. Thank you so much for your truly meaningful monthly support.
